Week of Prayer for Christian Unity began on Wednesday 18th January and continues until 25th January. The theme this year is "Belonging: Praying for Unity amidst Injustice". Here in Ireland, this year of 2023 marks the centenary of the formation of the Irish Council of Churches and the 50th anniversary of the Ballymascanlon Talks in 1973 which led to the formation of the Irish Inter-Church Meeting. Today, these bodies for inter-church dialogue in Ireland enable Christians to pray and work together for peace, reconciliation and social justice throughout Ireland.
