WORLD DAY OF PRAYER 2024 - The annual World Day of Prayer service will take place in Holy Trinity Church of Ireland, Lisnaskea on **next Friday, 1st March 2024 at 8pm**. This is a service celebrated together each year by the four main Churches in the town as part of a global celebration held in over 170 countries worldwide. Everyone is very welcome to attend. Refreshments will be served after the service.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS for Lent commencing in St. Mary's on Wednesday 21st February at 7pm and in Holy Cross on Thursday 22nd February at 7pm. The Stations will continue each week on the respective evenings during Lent. This is an opportunity to start preparations for Easter.

On Monday the 26th February at 10am, Tuesday 27th at 7pm and Wednesday 28th February at 10am, sisters from the Ukraine will have a stall at the back of Holy Cross Church for you to purchase some of their wares. The Sisters look after 200 orphans with psychophysical deficiencies for more than 14 years. Whatever financial support they receive purchases diapers for the bedridden children to the implementation of different activities on their rehabilitation and socialization. They also provide shelter for the homeless, drug or alcohol addicts and ex-prisoners. They also provide workshops, sewing and embroidery shops, candle workshop, wood-carving, stone and blacksmith workshops and many more. Together with the sisters these people produce beautiful articles with love and prayer in the convent's workshops. These will be available for purchasing, please support.
