- **1. Covid:** Need to be weary and look after the vulnerable. Continue to try to be sensitive. Ventilation to be kept going. Encouraging mask wearing note in bulletin encouraging this.
- **2. Net Ministry:** Disappointed Net Ministry not coming / didn't arrive no visas. Youth Ministry Team to meet and look for ideas.
- 3. Feedback from Mission Committee: Tea after 10am Mass on Wednesday or Thursday in Holy Cross. Note in bulletin to look for volunteers to a meeting in the Church after Mass. New people were brought on board during the Mission keep these people involved. Encourage more youth to get involved as Eucharistic Ministers in St. Mary's try and recruit. Work in conjunction with the Youth Ministry that will be developed. Invite Motivational speakers twice a year possible November and Lent. Congregational singing to be encouraged. Introduce the hymns encourage people to bring their Mission booklets with them. Use as an opportunity to expand St. Mary's choir. Faith and Light to be invited to hold their fiesta's at the public Masses with tea afterwards in the Parish Centre. Reintroduce the Sign of Peace in precovid form. Announce at Mass. Not encouraging shaking hands. Nod / wave / verbal
- **4. Baptism Team:** Up and running again. Team members visited the homes and attended the baptisms
- **5. Bereavement Team:** Progressing. Requested more training before visit homes. Aisling Centre will provide training 4 sessions also therapy for children bereaved. Also investigating Rainbows an organisation for children who have lost their parents through divorce, separation or bereavement
- 6. **200**th **Anniversary of St. Mary's Church and of Fr McGonnell's death:** progressing towards the centinerary Mass and the Mass for all deceased babies.

- **7. Review of work with John Bennett:** Ongoing. Reminder of the Vision Team taking more ownership and getting people involved. Creating direct links with Church groups how do we do this? Promoting team publicly
